## Washington Drug Card – Discount Prescriptions

The Washington Drug Card is a free statewide discount prescription assistance program designed to assist uninsured and underinsured residents in paying for their medications. Washington residents can download a free card and locate participating pharmacies by visiting [www.washingtondrugcard.com](http://www.washingtondrugcard.com).

The program can be used to supplement most health insurance plans including Health Savings Accounts and High Deductible Plans. It can also be used as a Medicare Part D supplement by providing discounts on non-covered drugs. Average savings are roughly 30 percent.
